**The Branch Creek Shiraz (Australia)** £3.70 £14.00

An easy drinking Shiraz with a good ripe tannin structure making it friendly and approachable.

**Cotes du Rhone Rouge Cuvee des Prelats Louis Bernard (France)** £18.00

Soft, juicy Cotes du Rhone with classic strawberry Grenache fruit matched with Syrah's peppery spice

**Baron de Luze Bordeaux Rouge (France)** £22.00

A soft, smooth claret showing crisp victoria plum and blackcurrant fruit with a herbal note behind

**Chianti Rufina Fattoria di Basciano (Italy)** £27.00

Deep ruby red colour with garnet inflections. Concentrated nose showing plum and berry character.

**Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Reserva (Spain)** £32.00

A deliciously rounded mouthful, with soft, supple tannins, and hints of liquorice on the finish

**Soft and Rounded Red Wines**

**Valdiveso Merlot (Chile)** £4.00 £16.00

A classic Chilean Merlot that offers an awful lot of pleasure per pound.

**Castillo de Claivjo Rioja NV (Spain)** £4.20 £17.50

Soft & creamy palate bursting with red fruits & just enough tannins. Long finish!

**Saam Mountain Paarl Pinotage (South Africa)** £18.00

Juicy tannins and ripe, dark, fruit with hints of vanilla. The aftertaste is long, fruity and very elegant.

**Valdivieso Reserve Pinot Noir (Chile)** £24.00

Full bodied yet lively, being round and smooth, with good acidity, and a long flavoursome finish.

**Fleurie Millesime Cave de Fleurie (France)** £27.00

A striking and vivid red colour, with several punnets worth of red berry fruit on the nose and palate

**Casa de Piedra Caberent Sauvignon (Chile)** £3.50 £13.00

The palate is full-bodied, deliciously ripe and packed with fruit.

**Tarquino Malbec (Argentina)** £16.00

Blackberry and blackcurrant flavours lead to a long finish complemented by soft tannins.

**Delicato Family Vineyards Old Vine Zinfandel (USA)** £22.00

Full-bodied with black cherry, vanilla and pepper notes and ripe, soft tannins.
